The following notification will be published in the Extraordinary issue of the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, dated:23-06-2016.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (4) of section 3 of the Unorganised Workers’ Social Security Act, 2008(Central Act 33 of 2008) and in supersession of the orders issued in the G.O. first read above and the earlier orders issued in this regard, the Government hereby formulate the following “CHANDRANNA BIMA SCHEME” for the unorganised workers in the State.

Object of the Scheme

- (1) The main object of the scheme is to provide relief to the families of unorganized workers in case of death or disability of the unorganised worker leaving the families in great distress.
- (2) All India statistics indicates that the Andhra Pradesh is one of the States with large number of accidents. The death or disability due to accident of an unorganized worker results in misery to his family and hardship caused by reduced earnings and medical and other expenditure relating to the accident. Hence, there is every need to provide accident death and disability insurance to the worker towards social security. Further, even natural death of an unorganized worker results in undue hardship to the family members left by the worker who need to be provided some relief.
- (3) Government had already implemented social security scheme to the transport drivers in the unorganized sector on a pilot basis and on the working experience of the said scheme, it is felt appropriate to extend the social security scheme to all unorganized workers in the State with certain modifications to provide disability coverage also.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE SCHEME

- (1) All unorganised workers in the State in the age group of 18 to 70 years are eligible to be registered as unorganised workers and enrolled as beneficiaries of the Chandranna Bima Scheme.
- (2) All unorganised workers will be registered under the Unorganised Workers Social Security Act, 2008 and enrolled as beneficiaries under Chandranna Bima Scheme. Labour Department will be Nodal Department for implementation of the scheme and SERP will be scheme implementing agency.
- (3) The data of unorganized workers will be captured through the Smart Pulse Survey being conducted by the State Government.. Village Organisations shall assist in registration of unorganised workers and their enrollment in the Chandranna Bima Scheme. SERP shall organize through Village Organisation, Mandala Samakhya and Zilla Samakhya, data entry, maintenance of data base, honorarium / incentive to Bima Mitras for claims processing and support to nominees for filing of claim applications and Zilla Samakhya's Insurance Call Center management and scholarship processing and other connected matters. Village Organisation to receive Rs.15/- towards subscription and give acknowledgment. The amount to be shared by Village Organisations, Mandala Samakhyas and Zilla Samakhyas as per the guidelines issued by SERP.
- (4) Assistant Labour Officer of the Labour Department or such other officer as may be specified by the Commissioner of Labour shall be the Registering Authority.
- (5) The registered unorganised workers will be enrolled as members under State Accident Death and Disability Scheme and under Aam Admi Bima Yojana (AABY) and will also be covered under the Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY). The benefits under the Chandranna Bima Scheme are as follows:

(i) Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakh) Accident Death and total permanent disability relief:

Rs. 2,25,000/- (Rupees two lakh twenty five thousand) from State Accident Death and Disability Scheme, Rs.75,000/- (Rupees seventy five thousand) under Aam Admi Bima Yojana (AABY) and Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakh) from Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY).

(ii) up to Rs.3,62,500/- (Rupees three lakh sixty two thousand five hundred) Partial permanent disability relief:

Up to Rs. 2,25,000/- under State Accident and Disability Scheme – Rs.37,500/- under Aam Admi Bima Yojana (AABY) and Rs.1,00,000/- from Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY).

(iii) Rs.30,000/- for Natural Death relief under Aam Admi Bima Yojana (AABY).

(iv) Rs.1200/- p.a. towards scholarship per child upto two children of the beneficiary studying 9th, 10th, Intermediate or ITI.

6. All Zilla Samakhyas, Mandal Samakhyas, Village Organisations, Slum Level, Town/ City Level Federations are hereby notified as Workers Facilitation Centers under section 9 of the Unorganised Workers Social Security Act,2008 for facilitation of registration of unorganised workers, their enrollment in social security schemes, processing of claims and for delivery of such other services required for implementation of the scheme.

7. The details of the scheme and modalities of implementation of the scheme shall be as specified in the Annexure appended to this Notification.

ANNEXURE
"CHANDRANNA BIMA SCHEME"
(THE ANDHRA PRADESH UNORGANISED WORKERS SOCIAL SECURITY
SCHEME)

1. Short title, extent, application and commencement –

- (1) The scheme may be called the "CHANDRANNA BIMA SCHEME".
- (2) It extends to the whole of the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- (3) It shall apply to all Unorganised Workers in the State.
- (4) It shall come into force from the date specified by the Commissioner of Labour.

2. Definitions –

In this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires,

- (i) "Scheme" means Chandranna Bima Scheme which includes State Accident Death and Disability Scheme, Aam Admi Bima Yojana (AABY) and Pradhan Mantri Surksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY).
- (ii) "Unorganised worker" includes the following categories of workers employed in unorganised sector.
 - a) a home based worker, self employed worker or wage worker earning less than Rs. 15,000 per month
 - b) a small / marginal farmer having less than 5 acres of dry land / 2.5 acres of wet land
(An indicative list of categories of unorganised workers and also the categories who are not eligible for Registration appended)
- (iii) "Beneficiary" means an unorganised worker enrolled in the scheme.
- (iv) "Family" consists of the beneficiary, his or her spouse, unemployed son, unmarried daughter, widowed daughter if residing with the beneficiary, dependent parents and the widow and children of a deceased son, if any;
- (v) "Fund" means "The Andhra Pradesh Unorganised Workers Social Security Fund" constituted under this Scheme.
- (vi) "Nodal Department" means the Labour Department.
- (vii) "Implementing Agency" means Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty (SERP).
- (viii) "Registering authority" means the Assistant Labour Officer of the area or such other officer specified by the Commissioner of Labour for registration of unorganised workers under section 10 of the said Act.
- (ix) "Workers Facilitation Center" means a center established in accordance with section 9 of the said Act, for facilitation of registration of unorganized workers, their enrollment in social security schemes, processing of claims and for delivery of such other services required for implementation of the scheme. All Zilla Samakhyas, Mandal

Samakhyas, Village Organizations and Town Level Federations shall be Workers Facilitation Centers.

(x) "Act" means the Unorganised Workers Social Security Act, 2008.

Note: Words and expressions used in this scheme and not defined shall have the same meaning assigned to them in the Unorganised Workers Social Security Act, 2008.

3. Chandranna Bima Scheme benefits:

- (i) **Rs. 5 lakh for Accident Death and Total Permanent Disability:** Rs. 2,25,000/- (Rupees two lakh twenty five thousand) from State Accident Death and Disability Scheme, Rs.75,000/- (Rupees seventy five thousand) under Aam Admi Bima Yojana (AABY) and Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakh) from Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY).
- (ii) **Upto Rs.3,62,500/- for Partial Permanent Disability:** Upto Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees two lakh twenty five thousand) from State Accident Death and Disability Scheme, Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) from PMSBY and Rs.37,500 from AABY.
- (iii) **Rs.30,000/- for Natural Death** under Aam Admi Bima Yojana (AABY).
- (iv) **Rs.1200/- p.a. towards scholarship** per child upto two children of the beneficiary studying 9th, 10th, Intermediate or ITI.

Eligibility for benefits:

A. Unorganised workers in the age group of 18 to 59 years (in view of AABY norms):

- (i) Accident Death and Total Permanent Disability relief: Rs. 5 lakh.
- (ii) Partial Permanent Disability relief: up to Rs.3,62,500/- as per the component schemes norms.
- (iii) Natural Death relief: Rs.30,000/-
- (iv) Scholarship: Rs.1200/- per annum per child (upto two children).

B. Unorganised workers in the age group of 60 to 70 years:

- (i) Accident Death and Total Permanent Disability relief: Rs. 4.25 lakh.
 - (ii) Partial Permanent Disability relief: up to Rs.3,25,000/- as per the component schemes norms.
- Note: Not eligible for Natural death relief and scholarship as per AABY norms.

4. Constitution of the Fund

- (i) A Fund namely "Andhra Pradesh Unorganised Workers Social Security Fund" shall be constituted by opening an Account in any Public Sector Bank.
- (ii) The fund consists of:-
 - (a) Grants or loans from the State Government;
 - (b) Financial assistance from the Central Government,
 - (c) Cess Fund under the Andhra Pradesh Transport Drivers Social Security Scheme
 - (d) Contribution from the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other

Construction Workers Welfare Fund, in respect of the "Building Workers"

- (e) Contribution from the Andhra Pradesh Labour Welfare Fund, in respect of its member-unorganised workers
- (f) Appropriations from other Government Schemes;
- (g) Interest on investment of Fund in securities;
- (h) Donations / Contributions by the employers'
- (i) Contribution by the workers.
- (j) Other remittances.

(iii) Premium:

The premium payable for the first year is Rs. 12/- under PMSBY, Rs 100/- under AABY and Rs.22.50/- under the State Accident Death and Disability scheme. There is no premium for scholarship under AABY.

(iv) Source of fund:

Fund required towards annual premium for State Accident Death and Disability Scheme, AABY and PMSBY for 1.5 crore workers is Rs.131.75 crore. The Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, the Andhra Pradesh Transport Drivers Social Security Fund and the Andhra Pradesh Labour Welfare Board will pay the premium in respect of the unorganised workers eligible under the respective Schemes. The respective Boards shall regulate/integrate their existing welfare scheme benefits keeping in view the benefits under Chandranna Bima Scheme and pay their premium contribution, as may be decided by the Commissioner of Labour. The premium being paid by various Government Departments for AABY Scheme, National Family Benefit Scheme entitlement of the State, Premium for Apadbandhu Scheme and other similar budget amounts of Government Schemes will be appropriated towards the above premium amount, as they are all being integrated into this scheme. However, the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board shall make payment of the entire premium amount as an advance.

With regard to coverage of NREGA workers under the category of building and other construction worker, the directive of the Central Government (MOLE) under Section 60 of the Building and other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996 vide Letter.No.Z-20011/05/2010-BL of Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, dt:12.07.2013 shall be followed. The Central Government had directed the State Governments in the said letter to register all such workers who have completed 50 days of work in a year under NREGA, as building or other construction workers on the basis of simple process like self certification.

An amount equivalent to 10% of the premium may be utilized towards administration of the scheme including publicity which shall be provided by the APBOCWW Board.

The funds available under Central Schemes shall be dovetailed for optimum utilization of funds from both Central Government and State Government. Coverage of various categories of workers shall be such as to avoid overlapping and duplication.

For the first year the total premium shall be met as an advance from the APBOCWW Board funds which will be repaid from the other Welfare Boards and the Schemes etc.

From second year onwards the premium shall be met from the fund available under Central and State Welfare Schemes, Welfare Boards under the Labour Department and contribution from the employers and workers as may be decided by the Government.

The fund shall be applied for the purpose of this scheme. Without prejudice to the generality of powers in this respect, the fund may be applied in connection with the following activities:

- a) Cost of administering the scheme.
- b) Premium for Insurance Schemes for providing accidental death/natural death/total permanent disability/partial permanent disability insurance relief and scholarship to the children and such other benefits as may be notified by the Government from time to time
- c) Such other activities incidental to the implementation of the scheme.

5. Administrative and Financial Powers of the Commissioner of Labour:-

The Commissioner of Labour is the Chief Executive Officer of the State Social Security Board for Unorganised Workers and also Chandranna Bima Scheme. He may draft any officer of the Labour Department and welfare boards under the Labour Department for implementation of social security schemes.

The Commissioner of Labour shall exercise administrative and financial powers as may be required for implementation of the scheme.

The Commissioner of Labour shall operate the Fund Account and release the premium to the insurance companies and incur all expenditure on publicity, contingencies, services and purchase of articles and other logistics as per the procedure, necessary for implementation of the scheme.

6. Registration of unorganised workers:

(i) Eligibility for registration:

All unorganized workers in the age group of 18 to 70 years are eligible for registration.

(ii) Process of Registration of workers:

The unorganised worker may be enumerated during Smart Pulse Survey (SPS) by the State Government, and he has to pay Rs.15/- or such other amount as specified by the Commissioner of Labour to the Enumeration Team of the Village Organisation. He shall furnish other undertakings and certificates, application forms as are required under the Rules of the various component schemes and under the Unorganised Workers Social Security Act, 2008 to the Village Organization at the time of enumeration.

7. Development of software, maintenance of Data base:

The SERP shall administer the Data provided from SPS to the Chandranna Bima Data Base (CBDB) to facilitate enrollment of unorganised workers, online claim process and generation of MIS reports as specified by the Labour Department. A separate website shall be developed and hosted at URL (www.chandrannabima.ap.gov.in).

The Web Portal for the scheme will be maintained in close coordination with the ITE&C Department, duly ensuring that the database is integrated with CM Dashboard, E-Pragathi and other related applications through Lead District Managers.

SERP should maintain liaison with the State Level Bankers Committee (SLBC) for their cooperation in effective implementation of PMSBY scheme by way of smooth flow of data from individual banks to Chandranna Bima database and vice-versa.

8. Database:

Data provided by the SPS shall be the Database for Chandranna Bima Scheme. The IT E & C Department shall capture the data required for Chandranna Bima Database and provide to the SERP/Labour Department at weekly intervals.

9. Enrollment of Unorganised Workers in the component Schemes and Monitoring:

Submission of application forms to the Banks for opening bank account and coverage under PMSBY:

In case of workers not having bank account and not covered in PMSBY, the Mandal / Town enrollment team has to collect the application for opening PMJDY bank account and coverage in PMSBY and submit to the bank through the Lead District Manager.

Monitoring:

The Commissioner of Labour may constitute Monitoring Committees at various levels, for effective implementation of the Scheme.

Awareness generation:

- Labour Department will develop the IEC material (pamphlets, posters, Flexies, Audio & Video material and distribute to the Labour Unions, Gram Panchayats, Village Organisations in Rural Areas, Slum Level Federations in Urban areas to create awareness on Chandranna Bima. The publicity shall commence from 15th June, 2016 and to continue for one month.
- Department of Labour will make Short Films on CHANDRANNA BIMA which will be displayed in all cinema theatres. Publicity may be taken up through TV ads and Radio jingles also.

Distribution of Insurance Policy certificates:

- Laminated Insurance Policy Certificates shall be distributed to the workers in the Janma Bhoomi programme to be specified by the Government. Habitation / Ward Enrollment teams shall be responsible for distribution of the Insurance Policy Certificates to the enrolled workers in the Janma Bhoomi programme. Cost of lamination of Insurance Certificate shall be met by the Labour Department.

Grievances Redressal:

- Any grievance related to registration of worker may be addressed to the Asst. Labour Officer. Grievance related to enrollment in the scheme and settlement of claims may be addressed to the PD DRDA. An appeal lies to the District Collector.

Settlement of Claims:

- The District Call Center run by Zilla Mahila Samakhya shall process the Claims under the scheme in coordination with the insurance agencies and ensure that claim amount is disbursed to the worker / family within 30 days from the date of receipt of the application.
- The Zilla Mahila Samakhya shall ensure that the insurance companies disburse the claim amount to the worker / nominee of the worker by online transfer to their bank account (DBT).

MOU with Insurance Companies and other agencies:

- The Commissioner of Labour shall enter into MOU with Insurance Companies and other agencies involved in the process of implementation of the scheme.
- SERP shall coordinate the functioning of the Village Organisations, Mandal and Zilla Mahila Samakhyas and shall furnish to the Commissioner of Labour details of progress of registration of workers, enrollment in the scheme and settlement of claims and any issue with regard to implementation of the scheme.

Power to remove difficulties:

- If any difficulty or doubt arises as to the interpretation of any of the provisions of the Scheme, the decision of the Government shall be final and binding. The Government may call for report from the Commissioner of Labour on technical issues like eligibility and on the Chief Executive Officer, SERP, on implementation issues.

Power to amend the scheme:

- The State Government, may by notification in the official Gazette, modify or amend the Scheme for its proper implementation and in the interests of the unorganised workers.
