1. That he is an inspector appointed under the Act. During my recent inspection on dt. 3-2-2016 @ 10, it is found that the opponent is paying less wages to his employees than prescribed under the Act. Details are shown in bottom of the notice.
2. The applicant estimates the value of the relief sought for the employees at the sum of Rs. 393/- towards difference of wages and Rs. .... Towards 10 times compensation.
3. The applicant prays that a direction may be issued under sec 20(3) for
  - a. Payment of the difference between the Wages due according to the minimum rate of wages fix Government the wages actually paid, and
  - b. Compensation amount to ten times the claim amount
  - c. Under sec. 22-B for Prosecution of the Employer
4. The applicant begs leave to amend or add to or make alterations in the application if and when necessary
5. The applicant does solemnly declare that what is stated above is true to the best of his knowledge, belief and information.
